OPERATION MEDICINE DROP



Poisoning from prescription medication is a growing problem in North Carolina. Since 1999 nearly 4,500 people have died from prescription drug poisoning. Let Operation Medicine Drop protect your family. Bring your expired, unused prescriptions to a drop-off site where they can be properly disposed of by law enforcement. The Mt. Airy Police Department is partnering with Safe Kids Northwest Piedmont and the Surry County Sherriff's Office to keep families safe, and prevent accidental poisoning.

On Wednesday, March 17, 2010 from 2:00pm- 6:00pm individuals can drop off their unused prescriptions (with no questions asked) at the Wal-Mart parking lot in Mt. Airy.
