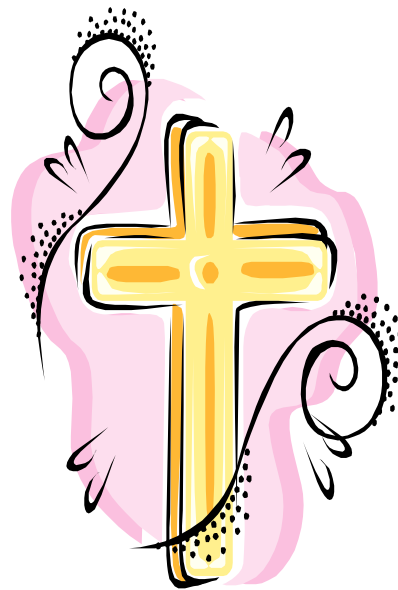

The white drape on the cross is made of "tow." This is a home-woven length of rough linen using thread spun from flax. Christ would have worn clothing made of tow and his broken body would have been wound with strips of tow that were soaked with oils and herbs. These strips were left in the empty tomb. The crown of thorns is similar to the one Jesus bore for us.
