Operation InAsMuch

During the month of April our church will participate in two mission projects.

1. The first project is *Operation Bulldog Backpack*. A number of children at Franklin Elementary School do not have enough food at home to eat. On Friday afternoon these children discretely go to a certain location at the school and pick up a backpack full of food to take home for the weekend. On April 11 and 18 the church will collect non-perishable food items to help fill this need. Please put your food items in the box marked Franklin School on the table by the nursery or in the bag provided in your Sunday School class. You may also make a monetary donation, make checks payable to Franklin Elementary School.



2. The second project is the annual *Food Roundup* to benefit the Baptist Children's Home of North Carolina. Each year Baptist churches across the state collect specific items to help support these children. Our church will collect paper products through Sunday, April 25. Please bring paper towels, napkins, toilet tissue, Kleenex, foil and plastic wrap and place it in the appropriate box on the table by the nursery.

If each person at Calvary would bring one item for each of these projects just think what a difference it would make in helping these children. It is truly a blessing to see what wonderful things happen when we join our hearts and hands to make a difference in the life of a child.
