Following the receipt of the "Pastoral Leadership Expectations Survey," the Committee can then finalize the qualifications for the next pastor and begin advertising the position. We will keep you informed as we progress.

Sunday, August 1, at 11 a.m. has been set for the Commissioning Service for the PSC. At that time, the Transition Team will present its body of work to the Committee as the foundation for the task of finding a pastor.
