### NEW FOR WEDNESDAY NIGHTS!

On Wednesday, October 12, a new series of Bible studies will begin during our Wednesday night discipleship time. Carol Lowe will be leading a session discussing the book by Calvin Miller entitled Jesus Loves Me. Do you fully grasp the words of this simple children's song? "No other song more succinctly and plainly states the basic elements of our faith. Come explore this children's song verse by verse, and be reminded that God loves us first, and He will love us last, even in the midst of our everyday grind. Problems at home? Yes, but Jesus loves you. Problems at work? Perhaps, but Jesus loves you. Problems with money, children, love? Yes, yes, yes...but Jesus loves you. Deepen your understanding of God's love and be inspired to a deeper faith." (C. Miller)
