Two Miles of Pennies Campaign—The theme of this year's Baptist Children's Homes' Annual Offering is "Growing Hope" and it celebrates the glorious hope we have through Jesus Christ, and the cultivation of that hope evident in the lives of children and families we touch. Calvary's goal again this year will be TWO MILES OF PENNIES or \$1,689.60. (Pennies are not required. Other coins or dollar bills serve the same purpose.) These offerings will be collected beginning October 4. Last year, it took Calvary until January to meet our goal. Let's be committed to wrapping up this year's offering by November 29.

On Sunday, November 1, Mr. Blake Ragsdale, who is a communications associate for the Baptist Children's Homes, will be delivering the message in both of our services.

Please consider the following suggestions for participating in this missions effort:

1. Pray for this statewide offering and about Calvary's and your participation in it.
2. Parents, motivate your children to collect pennies during October and November (A 12oz. soda can can hold about 550 pennies) and show them that you too are participating.
3. Sunday School classes, make this offering one of your missions projects.
4. Don't wait until the last minute. Get started today.

Operation Christmas Child—We will collect gift-filled shoeboxes now through November 23. Last year we collected 69 shoe boxes. Our goal this year is 100.
