And live from day to day.

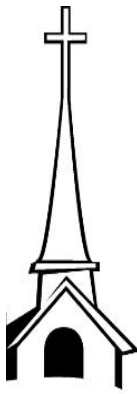

# Mission Opportunities



**Franklin Elementary Backpack Program:** By donating nutritious and convenient food items, you can help fill backpacks that are sent home with kids in need to insure that they’re able to eat healthy over the weekend. In October, we’re collecting single-serve breakfast items (Pop-Tarts, Nutri-Grain or Granola bars, single-serve cereal boxes, oatmeal packets, etc).

**Mile of Pennies Offering** to benefit the North Carolina Baptist Children’s Home. Our goal this year is to collect **2 and ½ Miles of Pennies** (\$2,112)! The deadline to participate is Sunday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>.



**Operation Christmas Child.** Calvary Baptist hopes to collect no fewer than 135 shoeboxes this year – shoeboxes that will help share the love of Jesus with children in parts of our world that have been devastated by war and natural disasters. Our collections deadline will be **Sunday, November 13**; and if you’d like to participate, here are some important things to remember:

Start with an empty shoebox or plastic container. You can wrap you box (lid separately), but wrapping is not required.

Decide whether your gift will be for a boy or a girl and select the appropriate age category: 2-4, 5-9 or 10-14. Be sure to mark your box with the correct age and gender.

Fill your box with a variety of gifts. Include small toys, school supplies and personal hygiene items; but **do not include** used items, war-related toys, chocolate or perishable food items, liquids, medicines or breakable items.

**Be sure to include a check for \$7** (made payable to Samaritan’s Purse) in your box to cover the costs of shipping and processing.
