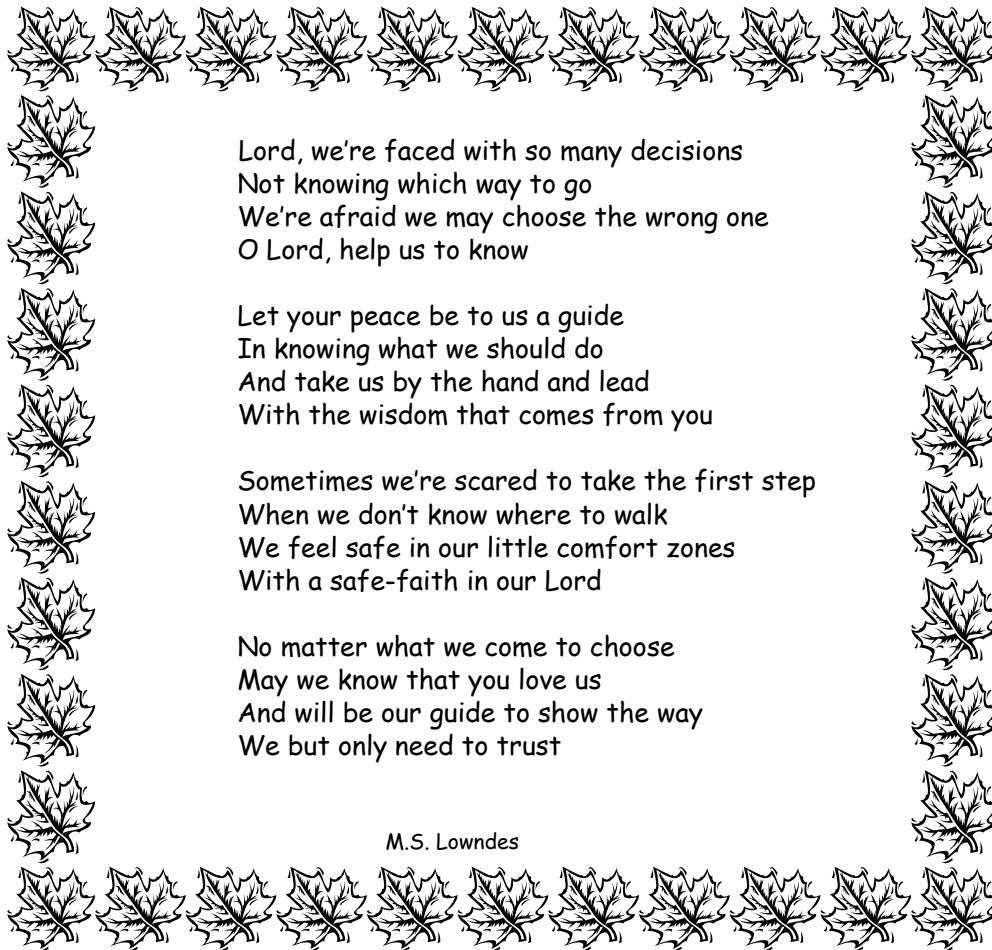

Operation Christmas Child

Calvary Baptist hopes to collect no fewer than 135 shoeboxes this year – shoeboxes that will help share the love of Jesus with children in parts of our world that have been devastated by war and natural disasters. Our collections deadline will be **Sunday, November 13**; and if you'd like to participate, here are some important things to remember:



Start with an empty shoebox or plastic container. You can wrap your box (lid separately), but wrapping is not required.

Decide whether your gift will be for a boy or a girl and select the appropriate age category: 2-4, 5-9 or 10-14. Be sure to mark your box with the correct age and gender.

Fill your box with a variety of gifts. Include small toys, school supplies and personal hygiene items; but **do not include** used items, war-related toys, chocolate or perishable food items, liquids, medicines or breakable items.

Be sure to include a check for \$7 (made payable to Samaritan's Purse) in your box to cover the costs of shipping and processing.

Empty Stocking



The Christmas season is quickly approaching and we would like to have your support again as a sponsor for children in need. Surry County Schools will be collaborating with the **Salvation Army** to assist needy families during Christmas. If you would like to sponsor one or more children from Franklin Elementary School please contact Melissa Hart at 786-2459 no later than October 31, 2011. Each sponsor will be given an "angel" with information for shopping purposes by November 21, 2011. This will include a wish list and sizes for each child. The recommended amount per child is approximately \$100.00. The Salvation Army asks that we please do not wrap any items; simply bag all items in a large garbage bag with the ID number on the outside of the bag. They also ask that no large or expensive items be purchased, such as: bikes, digital accessories, games boys, etc. Items will need to be delivered to the Salvation Army's satellite distribution center located on Renfro Street behind McDonald's in the empty space beside Ollie's. If you choose not to shop, you may give monetary donations to the school's Empty Stocking Fund. Donations will be used to purchase items for children who do not have sponsors. All donations need to be delivered to this location on or before December 12. Hours of operation are Monday-Friday from 9:00-11:30AM or 1:30-4:00 PM. Thank you.

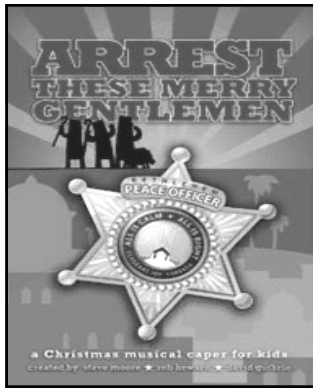

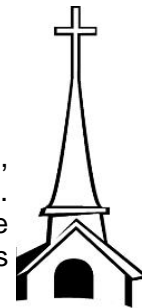
ARREST These Merry Gentlemen rehearsals begin this Sunday at 4:00p.m. until 5:00p.m.

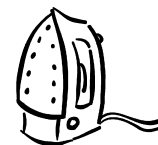
