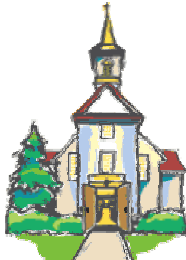

because it means you've made a difference.

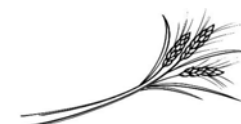
