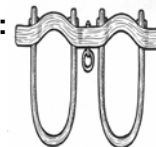

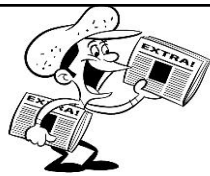

Info: More information will be released as we get closer to the event.

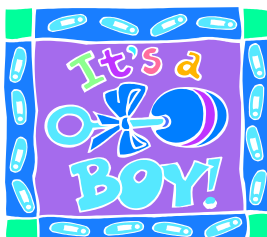
### **August 18th – WS Dash**
