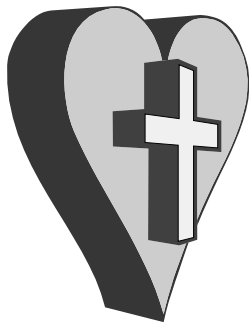

WEEKLY ACTIVITIES FOR CHILDREN (GRADES K-6)

◆ WORSHIP - SUNDAYS AT 8:30 AM AND 10:55 AM

Children are encouraged to attend worship before or after Sunday School. Each week children are invited to the front of the sanctuary for **Children's Corner** in Traditional Worship. This time, led by the pastor and others, is devoted to giving the children a time during the main worship service just for them.

Our music team of Paulette Surratt and Tony Dalton are working with established groups, such as the *Calvary Belles* (a women’s ensemble) and the *Calvary Hymns* (a male ensemble) while working to expand our music ministry to include other groups, both vocal and instrumental. We have a **Sanctuary Band** and have developed a *Praise and Worship Team* (vocalists and instrumentalists) for *Uplift* Worship. Adults and youth are invited to join the *Uplift* Team. A *Youth Praise Choir* prepares music for worship, special events, and musicals to take on tour.

Paulette and Tony welcome persons to volunteer to be involved in new and innovative ways with music.

◆ ADULT SANCTUARY CHOIR REHEARSAL WEDNESDAY - 7:15 - 8:30 PM

The adult Sanctuary Choir is under the direction of Minister of Music Paulette Surratt. This choir focuses on leading the music of the Sunday morning services each week, and presents special musical/drama programs at Christmas, Easter and other occasions. Opportunities are available for choir members to join ensemble groups as well as contributing through solos.
